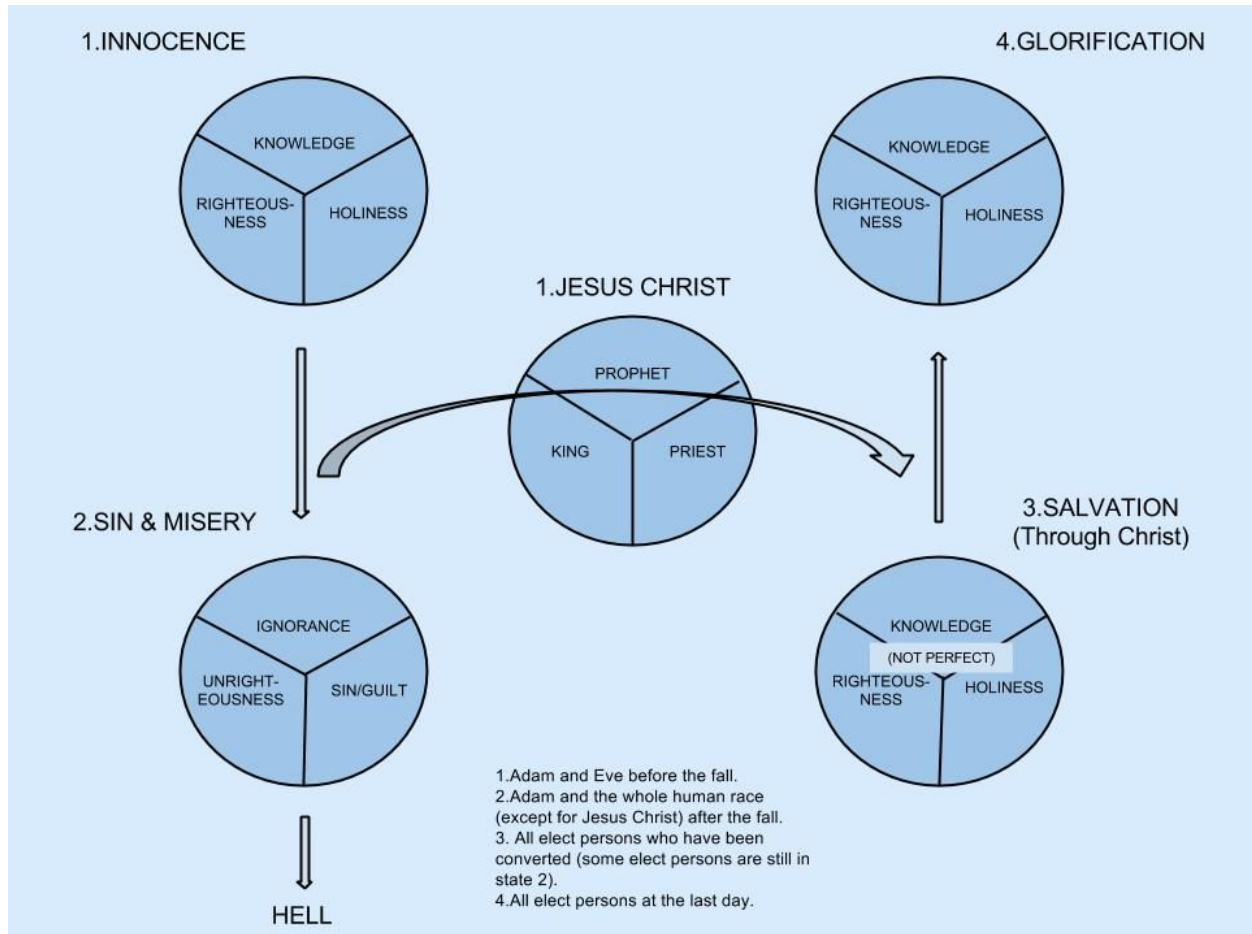


Salvation Chart



Answer - God created man male and female, after his own image,¹ in knowledge, righteous-ness, and holiness,² with dominion over the creatures.³

1. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. (Gen. 1:27)

2. And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him (Col. 3:10). And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness (Eph. 4:24).

3. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth (Gen. 1:28).

2. Question - Into what estate did the fall bring mankind?

Answer - The fall brought mankind into an estate of sin and misery.¹

1. For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God (Rom. 3:23). Destruction and misery are in their ways (Rom. 3:16).

3. Question - Did God leave all mankind to perish in the estate of sin and misery?

Answer - God having, out of His mere good pleasure, from all eternity, elected some to everlasting life,¹ did enter into a covenant of grace, to deliver them out of the estate of sin and misery, and to bring them into an estate of salvation by a Redeemer.²

1. According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world (Eph. 1:4).
2. But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe (Rom. 3:21-22)

4. Question - What benefits do believers receive from Christ at the resurrection?

Answer - At the resurrection, believers being raised up in glory,¹ shall be openly acknowledged and acquitted in the day of judgment,² and made perfectly blessed in the full enjoying of God³ to all eternity.⁴

1. all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, and shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life ... (John 5:28-29).
2. Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven (Matt. 10:32). Well done, good and faithful servant ... enter thou into the joy of thy Lord (Matt. 25:23)
3. ... we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is (1John 3.2). For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face (1 Cor. 13:12)
4. ... so shall we ever be with the Lord (1 Thess. 4:17).

JESUS CHRIST

Question - Who is the Redeemer of God's elect?

Answer - The only Redeemer of God's elect is the Lord Jesus Christ,¹ who, being the eternal Son of God, became man,² and so was and continueth to be, God and man in two distinct natures, and one person,³ for ever.⁴

1. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus (1 Tim. 2:5).
2. And the word was made flesh, and dwelt among us (John 1:14).

3. Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen (Rom. 9:5)
4. But this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood (Heb. 7:24)

Question - How did Christ, being the Son of God, become man?

Answer - Christ, the Son of God, became man by taking to himself a true body,¹ and a reasonable soul,² being conceived by the power of the Holy Ghost, in the womb of the Virgin Mary, and born of her,³ yet without sin.⁴

1. Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same (Heb. 2:14).
2. Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death (Matt. 26:38).
3. Behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS (Luke 1:31). The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee (Luke 1:35).
4. Such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, underfiled, separate from sinners (Heb. 7:26).

Question - What offices doth Christ execute as our Redeemer?

Answer - Christ, as our Redeemer, executeth the offices of a prophet,¹ of a priest,² and of a king,³ both in his estate of humiliation and exaltation.

1. Moses truly unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you (Acts 3:22).
2. Thou art a priest for ever, after the order of Melchisedec (Heb. 5:6).
3. Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion (Ps. 2:6).
