
THE TRINITY CHART



The subsistence and operation of the three persons in the divine Being is marked by a certain definite order. The Father is neither begotten by, nor proceeds from any other person; the Son is eternally begotten of the Father, and the Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son from all eternity.

The eternal generation of the Son.

The Bible speaks of the Son as the Logos.

A definition of the generation is;

It is that eternal and necessary action of the first person of the Trinity, whereby He, within the divine being, is the ground of a second personal subsistence like His own, and puts this second person in possession of the whole divine essence, without any division, alienation, or change.

The procession of the Holy Spirit is called 'Spiration'. Spiration may be defined as that eternal and necessary action of the first and second persons of the Trinity whereby they, within the divine Being, become the ground of the personal subsistence of the Holy Spirit, and put the third person in possession of the whole divine essence, without any division, alienation or change.
