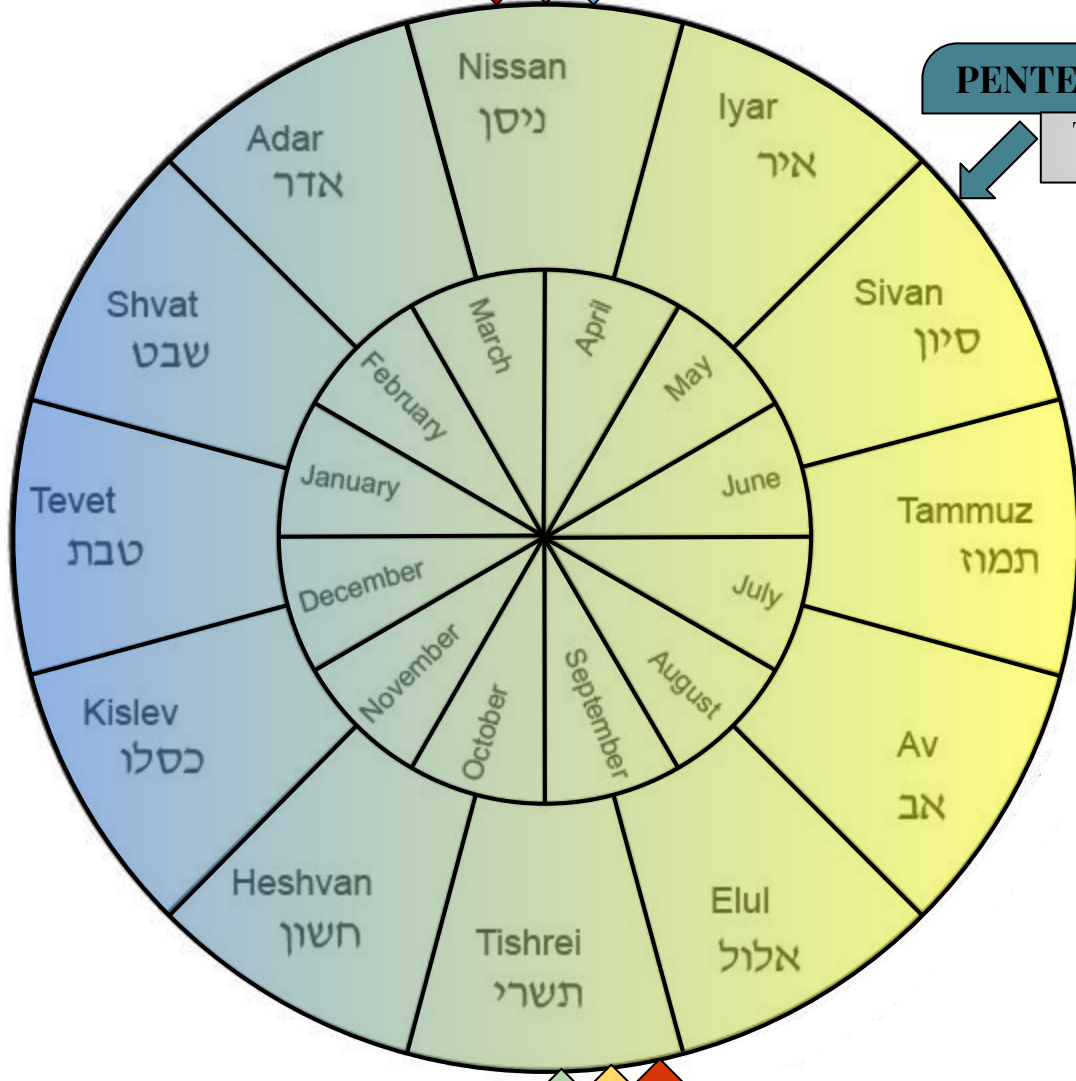

**5.The Feast of Trumpets**  
A type of the call to repentance and of the preaching the gospel. "Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and show my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins." Isa 58:1. "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature" Mark 16:15. It was in preparation for the day of Atonement. It is also a type of the "trump" on the Last Day.

**6.The Day of Atonement**  
Aaron the high priest made sin offerings for himself and for the people, and sprinkled the blood upon the mercyseat in the most holy place; confessed the sins of the people over the scapegoat, and sent it away into the wilderness; and offered burnt offerings for himself and for the people. Lev.16. Thus a type of the atoning work of Christ for His people.

**7.The Feast of Tabernacles**  
A type of our close relationship with God. His deliverance from spiritual bondage (Egypt) and His guidance in life; and of Heaven. Revelation 21:3,4.

**1.The Feast of the Passover**  
What did the Passover teach the Jews and what must it teach us? To remember their deliverance by blood, and to look for our own deliverance by the same means in Christ  
1 Cor 5:7 (14th Nissan)

**2.The Feast of Unleavened Bread**  
There must be no leaven in anything which typified Christ; and for this reason it was forbidden to be offered in the bread eaten at the passover, for throughout the Word it always represents evil. (15th Nissan 7 day festival)

**3.The Feast of the Firstfruits**  
Whom did the first sheaf of the crop represent? "Now is Christ risen from the dead and became the firstfruits of them that slept." 1 Corinthians 15:20 (16th Nissan)

**4.The Feast of Pentecost**  
This feast was a type of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, fifty days after Christ our Passover was sacrificed for us, when the apostles received the first fruits of the Spirit, and presented to God the firstfruit converts of the Christian Church. The two loaves representing both Jews and Gentiles together; Acts 2.
